Breastfeeding Friendly Early Childhood Education Policy Template 1

<Organisation name> is a breast/chestfeeding friendly Early Childhood Education (ECE) Centre. We acknowledge the importance of breast/chestfeeding for whānau/families, recognising breastfeeding as providing many positive benefits beyond nutrition. We understand that enrolling your pēpi/tamariki/children in ECE can be a significant barrier to continuing breast/chestfeeding for many whānau/families. As an organisation we aim to support our whānau/families to continue breast/chestfeeding after enrolling in ECE.

As such, we have implemented the following initiatives to achieve a Breastfeeding Friendly ECE certification:

- We will ensure that all kaiako/teachers at the centre are educated on the importance of breast/chestfeeding, are enthusiastically supportive of breast/chestfeeding at any age or stage.
- We will ensure that breast/chestfeeding requirements are discussed with all whānau/amilies that enrol in our centre at the time of enrolment or as whānau deem necessary.
- We will take any practicable steps to ensure whānau/families feel comfortable to breast/chestfeed anywhere in the centre at any time during centre hours.
- We will provide adequate facilities for breast/chestfeeding within the centre (wash basin, fridge space for expressed breast milk, and a power outlet for pumping).
- We will ensure that all kaiako/teachers are trained and competent in the correct handling and preparation of expressed breast milk.
- We will review this policy periodically and ensure it is kept up to date.

We have identified a room onsite, where our centre whānau/families are able to breast/chestfeed or express breast milk in privacy.

Tolerance
